

This video introduces the concept of trophic cascades, an important concept when thinking about animal reintroductions, through the lens of wolf reintroduction in Yellowstone National Park. Although the video is not explicitly regarding Grizzly Bears, the same concepts from this video can be applied to them as well. Ask your students how they think that bears shape their ecosystem.
